Pursuing the Best Interest of the Child during the Crisis of the Family

The focus of the seminars is to present the most recent European debates concerning family relationships and children's protection. In particular, they will explore the roles played by EU and ECtHR's case-law both in the development of comparative studies on family law and on the recent legislative initiatives drafted, proposed or enacted in several European systems.
