**Verica Trstenjak** (national of Slovenia, based in Austria) is a lawyer **and former Advocate General of the European Court of Justice in Luxembourg** and former **judge at the General Court of the European Union** in Luxembourg and a professor of European Union law in Austria and Slovenia.

From 2019 she is member of the **Permanent Court of arbitration in The Hague**. She is also conciliator at the **Court of Conciliation and Arbitration within the OSCE (Organisation for Security and Co-operation in Europe)** and member of the Bureau at this Court (from 2019). From 2017-2022 she was **Member of Management Board and from October 2017 also Member of Executive Board of the EU Agency for fundamental rights**. She is also a member of the advisory **Board** (similar to arbitration) **of the international organization Energy community** and an external scientific member of the **Max Planck Institute Luxembourg**. Since 2020 she is a substitute member of **Venice Commission** (Council of Europe). She is a member of the European Academy of Sciences and Arts (Salzburg) and of Academia Europaea (London). In 2020 she got an Austrian state decoration from Austrian President van der Bellen: Cross of Honour for Science and Art, First Class.
